

Student welfare activities of Teachers' Council of BKC College

In view of the current pandemic situation and considering the economic hardship faced by the families of some of our students, the Teachers' Council of Brahmananda Keshab Chandra College has decided to help the needy students. Initially, the Teachers' Council spent around Rs 59,000/- from its fund towards payment of tuitions fees, examination fees and data recharge of mobile phone of students. Council paid the tuition fees of 35 B.Sc. honours students and the university examination fees of 45 students from both arts and science stream. The data recharge helped 11 students to carry on with their online classes and other online activities. These activities were carried during the end of last year.

As the situation got worsened with the second wave of COVID -19 and the continued economic uncertainties of a large section of our student community, the council members took the decision to build " Student Welfare Fund" from individual donation under the supervision of the Secretary. It got good response from the teachers and the fund soon crossed fifty thousand rupees. While taking online classes, teachers found that some students are regularly absent from their classes as they are unable to recharge their mobile data pack. So it was decided that the foremost thing will be to help the students to continue with their online classes. Recently, data pack recharge, valid for eighty four days, was done for 53 students and around Rs 30,199/- was spent.

Apart from this, individual teachers have helped quite a large number of students in their personal capacity whenever they have come to know about their misery. We hope that we can increase these benevolent activities in future and the Teachers' Council will do it's bit to stand by as many students as it can.
